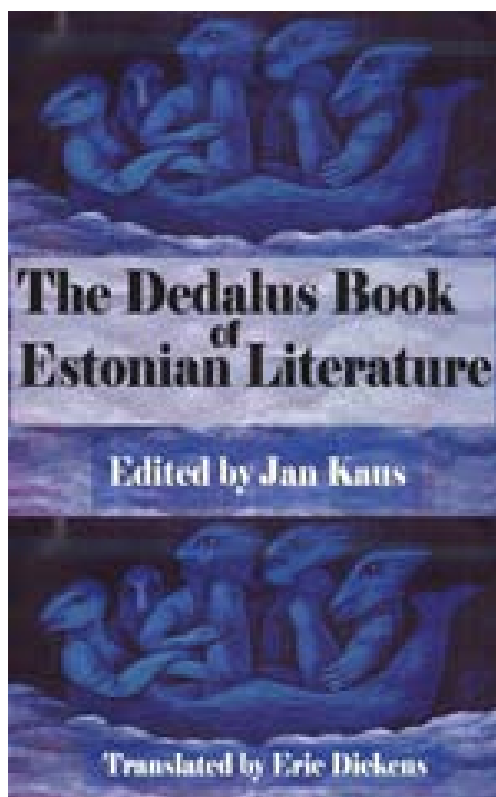


The Dedalus Book of Estonian Literature
