Exporting references - EBSCOhost



EndNote Basic is a free online reference management tool, which the Library can offer support for should you need it

Users can create an account by signing up through **Web of Science** – this provides additional citation styles and attachment storage

We recommend using a **personal email address** to register, so that access to the account continues after graduation

There is also an optional “**Cite While You Write**” plug-in for Microsoft Word (PC or Mac), which will insert citations and references into a document by linking directly to the online EndNote Basic account

There are different procedures for getting references into EndNote depending on which database you are using

- In EndNote, go to “Collect”, and then “Import References”

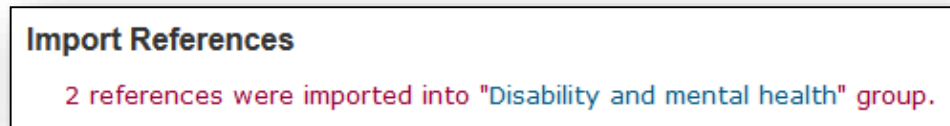
