

Data on Large Teaching Spaces

In 2018/19 the University had 9 rooms with a capacity \geq 250. This included 5 raked lectures theatres, maximum size of which was 314.

For future use (from 2022/23), aligned with the strategic direction for learning and teaching, the large flat-floored spaces are reconfigured to enable them to be used as collaborative learning spaces. They can still support more conventional modes of delivery, albeit at a reduced size than was previously the case.

Note: Bute Hall, given its use for ceremonial and other events which limits availability and because of difficulties in ensuring reliable AV/IT due to the nature of that space, will not be scheduled for general, patterned teaching.

CTT JMSLH:438 SALTIRE	N/A	500 (2 x 250)	500 seat divisible room, likely to be used most often in split format (2x250) . Prioritised for 'early adopters'.
CTT MAIN BLD:413 KELVIN GALLERY	350	232	Reconfigured to 232 seat collaborative learning space – similar in design to the large flat-floored spaces in JMS.
